Sokil (or Sokol) is a Slavic word meaning "hawk".

It is also the name of a mass youth physical-education movement important in the rise of nationalism in several Slavic peoples. The first Sokol Society was founded in Prague in 1862. The Ukrainian Sokil Society was founded in Lviv in February 1894.
